# Hobby Loss Audits in the Horse Industry

In hobby loss audits, the IRS sometimes views various types of horse activities as a means of generating tax losses, rather than a profit-oriented venture. Many cases that have ruled in favor of the taxpayer in horse or other livestock activities involve people who developed a superior line of animal. Taking a scientific approach to breeding is evidence showing a businesslike approach to the activity.

Careful research into pedigrees, for example, shows a concern for the proper application of genetics to your breeding program. Working with experts to develop a superior nutritional program is also evidence that you are using scientific means to enhance or at least maintain the health of your animals, and this in turn suggest you are operating a business rather than a hobby.

The use of scientific devices to help train animals is important in showing that your venture is conducted in a businesslike manner. For example, many people in the cutting hose industry utilize a “mechanical cow,” which is a device used to help train cutting horses. This product consists of a life-like mechanical cow which travels across a pen on cables. Movements of the cow are controlled by switches, and provide a variety of options.

Another area is agricultural science, which is important in helping to maximize the use of farmland--for instance to help eradicate problematic weeks. This in turn helps to promote thriving pastures. The use of scientific techniques is also important in that it helps reduce costs, thus making it more feasible to realize a profit.

Another recurring issue in horse and other livestock activities is “how many” animals constitute a decent sized herd that can generate a profit from breeding and selling. This depends on numerous variables, to mention the capabilities of the people involved in day-to-day management of the operations. Sometimes the IRS will argue in an audit, that the taxpayer has either “too many” or “too few” animals. In situations where the activity consists primarily of breeding broodmares and selling foals, the auditor might conclude that you have “two few” broodmares, and that this shows a lack of profit motive. This simply does not make sense. The IRS must keep in mind that there should be business reasons for increasing the size of one’s heard.

There is significant competition in selling animals. It is

important to focus one’s efforts on successful showing and marketing of one’s animals, one by one. To simply “increase” the size of one’s herd would present logistical and financial problems that the management of a medium size, quality herd does not pose.

If anything, taxpayers in many Tax Court cases are criticized for having too many animals. If there are “too many” animals, the IRS will want to know if you have any plans on culling some of them. Many Tax Court cases refer to the necessity of culling animals that are not being productive in the taxpayer’s breeding program.

These and other issues should be addressed not at the time of an audit, but beforehand during the course of developing one’s Business Plan. As I have previously said in this column, one of the best ways to insure that you are complying with the IRS hobby loss rule is have a formal Business Plan, or at least to have your situation reviewed by a tax attorney so as to analyze your existing operations, evaluate the strengths and the weaknesses, and obtain recommendations according to tax law on how the operations can be improved in order to meet IRS scrutiny.

One final point so often raised in hobby loss cases is the notion that the taxpayer’s family has an affectionate attachment to some of the horses, or that there are significant recreational elements involved. The IRS will try and find any bit of evidence--such as the participation of children -- to argue that your primary motivation is recreation, not business. This is really not a proper approach on the part of the IRS because many Tax Court cases have ruled in favor of taxpayers even though there were some elements of personal pleasure and recreation. For example, in *Burrus v. Commissioner*, T.C.Memo. 2003-285, the Tax Court ruled in favor of the taxpayer even though family members rode four or five horses on the property, and they held an annual dove hunt and barbecue for about 50 to 75 guests. Also, the taxpayer’s children and grandchildren visited the property many times, and would often canoe and fish on a pond located at the property. This was out weighed by other businesslike elements, such as breeding champion quality animals, that proved the taxpayer conducted the activity in a businesslike manner, despite the occasional recreational elements involved.



The **Arizona Stallion Stakes** is restricted to stallions standing in Arizona, but the foals need not be Arizona-bred. Stallions represented in this years stake include: Benton Creek (Dennis E. Weir), Hold For Gold (Zimmerman Farm LC), Top Hit (Triple AAA Ranch), Buck Strider (Sarival Farm) and Red Sky's (Joyce Long & Larry Kruidenier.).

Red Zeus, won the 2012 Breeders' Futurity, and also captured the Stallion Stakes Derby. He has won three races of 13 efforts for earnings of \$95,791.

Six three year-olds went to the post vying for a prize of \$40,310.00 at a distance of seven and one-half furlongs on the turf. Red Zeus owned/bred by Dick & Peggy Hopwood, trained by Dan McFarlane, and ridden by Kelly Bridges, drew off early and didn't look back. Red Zeus was the bettors favorite, after winning the Arizona Breeders Futurity November 24th. Hana and Listen You Fool, Miss Alex J, Sky's No Limit and Sweet Buck had their work cut out for them.

Kelly Bridges took Red Zeus directly to the front and was never challenged, winning by **sixteen lengths!!!**

Joyce Long & Larry Kruidenier nominated the stallion Red Sky's in 2009 hoping for this day. They received bonus monies of \$4,031.00.

The 75 acre ranch stands out as an oasis off Thunderbird Road west of Phoenix.



In Loving Memory of my Son John Corey Johnson

John Corey was born June 30, 1982, in Price, Utah. He was introduced to the racetrack at a very young age. He made it through basic training and was stationed in Ft. Drum, New York in July of 2010. It seemed like a million miles away and we all missed him. Things began to move very fast for him. At Christmas he announced that he was deployed at Afghanistan, but he was ready to do the job that he had been trained for. On March 18th, he boarded a plane that would eventually get him to a remote area of Afghanistan near the Pakistan border. We didn't hear from him too often, because they were busy building a new COP and establishing a stronghold. So when we did hear from him it became very scary as they lost their first soldier early on and almost immediately earned their combat infantry badge. On April 15th Corey's action would save the life of a fellow soldier and friend. He told me on the phone "Don't worry Mama, I am the best trained soldier in the world".

On the morning of May 27th, 2011 two Army officers came to our little cabin in Payson to bring me the news of my son. Apparently he was driving one of his commanders and their vehicle came under enemy attack. Some of the soldiers were injured but Corey laid down his life on the battlefield that day. Two months and ten days into his deployment his military career was over. He gave his life for his country and family that he loved so much. The soldiers who retrieved him from the vehicle fought long and hard. Two of them earned the Bronze star with valor for their actions and 4 earned Army commendations. I will be forever in their debt for what they did. Corey was laid to rest with the third highest honors possible.

Corey loved Arizona. He loved hunting and fishing and he loved the racetrack. He would tell me "Someday me and you will own a racehorse Mama." To that I would say "Someday Buddy"... someday meet me in the winner's circle. I love you so much.

I thank god for every minute that I got to spend with my son. I thank all of my racetrack family for supporting us through this tragic loss. Thank you to all the men and women who currently serve and protect this country today and a special thanks to Dennis Miller for the opportunity to share a bit of Corey with all of you. ❖



# Horseshoe Nails

For want of a nail, the shoe was lost.  
For want of a shoe, the horse was lost  
For want of a horse, the battle was lost.  
From loss of the battle, a war was lost.

Or something like that. I’m sure you’ve heard it before. The importance of horseshoe nails is often overlooked or misunderstood. Can you imagine that first darn fool who tried to drive a nail into the foot of a horse to hold a shoe in place? I’d pay money to have seen that rodeo.

History varies on the origin of iron horseshoes and horse-shoe nails. Most historians think they were introduced around 500 or 600 B.C. and came into common use around 1,000 A.D. At first they were probably used in war, rather than in agriculture. Historians differ on who the originators were. Some think they were the Romans, other think they were the Mongolians. Personally, I believe it was somebody who needed to make a truck payment.

For about 3,000 years horseshoers had to make each nail by hand, one at a time. In the mid-1800s Mr Daniel Dodge, Mr. Silas Putnam, and Mr. George Capewell all patented nail-making machines to mass produce horseshoe nails. With mass-produced horseshoes invented at about the same time, the need for blacksmithing skills diminished.

The horseshoe nail has come a long way since it was invented, and today we have more types and sizes of nails than ever. Every possible use and need has a nail. Nails are somewhat standardized in shape and size, but the key word here is “somewhat.”

A nail’s umber represents the size of the blade or shank, and the name represents the size and shape of the head. For a “5 city head,” for example, “5” is the size of the shank and “city” is the type of head the nail has.

Nail sizes range from 3 (smallest) to 16, with some half sizes. Common types of head are:

- City--the most widely used shoeing nail in the U.S. (I assume it was originally designed for use on paved roads.)
- Regular--a little larger than city head.
- Race--designed to be used in lightweight racing plates.

Other head styles are: classic, slim, lite, thin, and combo. Each head style comes in an array of blade and head shapes and sizes. In the last few years a new type, the E-nail, has been getting more use in the U.S. No, this isn’t some high-tech electronic nail, but the European-style of nail that has a wider square head offering more contact, than the standard rectangular American head.

The horseshoe nail has these parts: beveled point blade or shank, neck, head, and the crown or top. The head and point are beveled the same way so a nail driven into the hoof wall will turn outward and exit the wall, to be turned down and clinched.

When you drive a nail into a hoof take care not to quick the horse by nailing into the sensitive structure of the hoof. The white line is the guide to nailing: never nail to the inside of the white line—the horse will not like the result, and you will not like what happens next. Line up the shoe holes with the white line on the hoof, and don’t ever nail inside the white line.

The nail should exit about a thumb’s width above the hoof bottom. If you use light taps, the nail will come out low. If you use harder blows, the nail will come out higher. Nails at the toe will come out lower than nails in the quarters. Getting nail pitch and hammer blows just right requires practice.

As soon as the nail exits the hoof wall, wring it off so you won’t get stabbed in the hand, leg or whatever. Put the nail at the bottom of the claw of your driving hammer and twist the hammer. The nail will twist right off.

After the shoe is nailed on, bring the foot out in front of the horse and put it on a stand or on your knee so you can clinch the nail. First notch under each nail with a rasp or a tool made to do this. Then use a pair of clinchers to end each nail down and over. With your driving hammer set each nail by tapping it down into the hoof wall. Use a rasp to smooth off the clinches, being careful not to cut them off.

While there’s more to this business of nailing on a horse-shoe, this gives you a short look at the most important part of farrier work. No matter how nice the shoe or how neat the trim, nothing else counts without good nailing.

Entries not drawn into the body of the race will be placed on an also-eligible list in order of preference. To remain eligible for the Derby, horses do not have to start in the Futurities, however all sustaining payments must be made through October 15, 2015. To remain eligible for the Derby an additional \$300.00 is due January 15, 2016.

## ARIZONA THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS ASSOCIATION

The A.T.B.A. was organized in 1967 as a non-profit organization “dedicated to the betterment of the Thoroughbred industry in the State of Arizona”. Since 1967 the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders Association has had an influence on almost all aspect of racing laws and regulations which has benefitted all horsemen running in the State of Arizona.

The goal of the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders Association is to serve its membership and to grow into a strong viable organization with the ability to purchase land and build our own sales pavilion.

Fifteen directors serving for three years each on a rotating basis, govern the policy of the Association. The directors also assume duties during the year such as attending Arizona Racing Commission meetings and attend legislative matters pertaining to our industry.

The main source of income for the A.T.B.A. is our annual fall Thoroughbred mixed sale. Consignments come from all over the western part of the United States. All yearlings that are consigned and pass through the sale ring become eligible for the A.T.B.A. Spring & Fall Sales Stakes which are run the following May and October as 2 years old with an estimated purse of \$75,000. (May - \$25,000 bonus paid to an Arizona-bred winner, October - \$100,000 bonus paid to an Arizona-bred winner)
