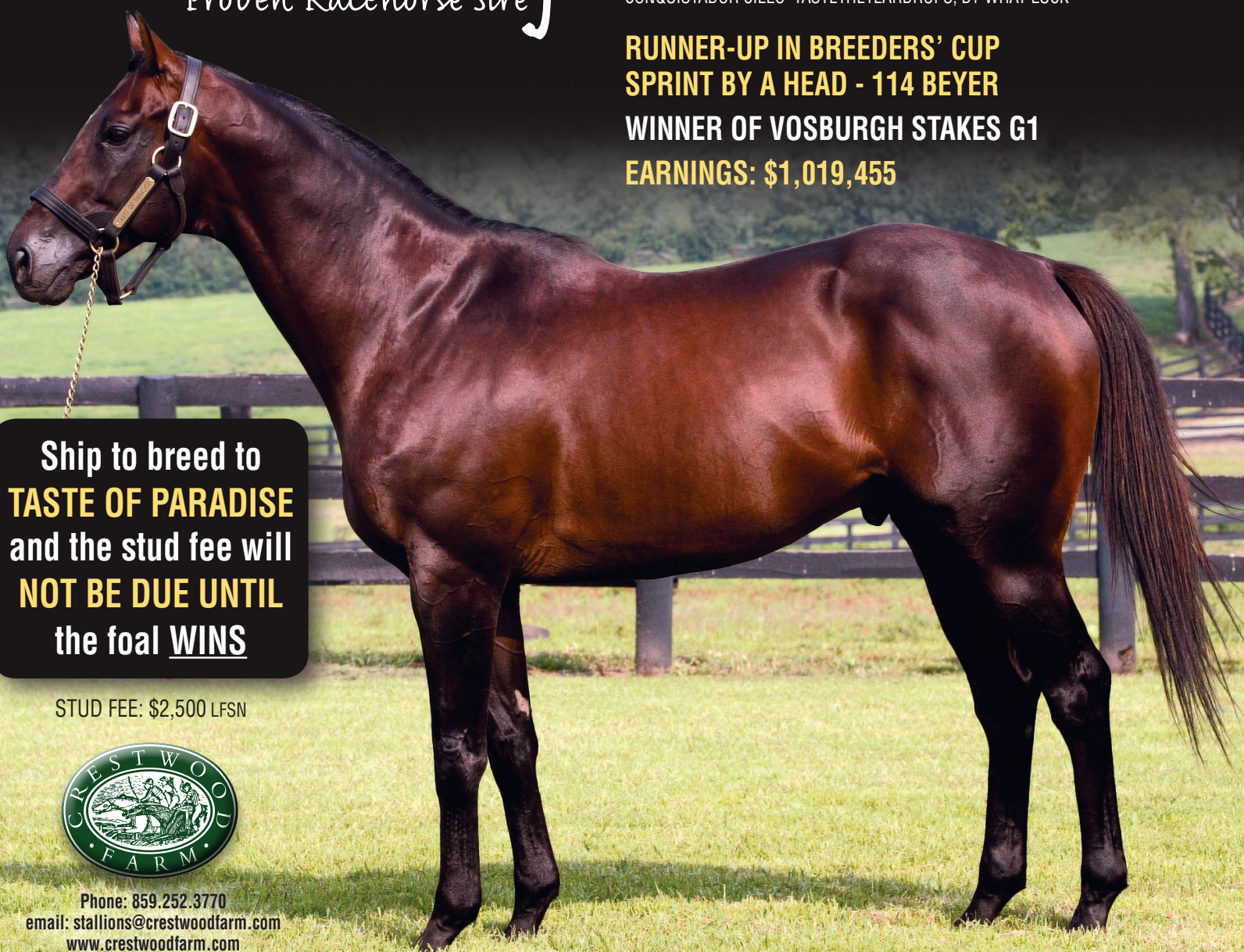

The A.T.B.A. was organized in 1967 as a non-profit organization "dedicated to the betterment of the Thoroughbred industry in the State of Arizona". Since 1967 the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders Association has had an influence on almost all aspect of racing laws and regulations which has benefitted all horsemen running in the State of Arizona.

The goal of the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders Association is to serve its membership and to grow into a strong viable organization with the ability to purchase land and build our own sales pavilion.

Fifteen directors serving for three years each on a rotating basis, govern the policy of the Association. The directors also assume duties during the year such as attending Arizona Racing Commission meetings and attend legislative matters pertaining to our industry.

The main source of income for the A.T.B.A. is our annual fall Thoroughbred mixed sale. Consignments come from all over the western part of the United States. All yearlings that are consigned and pass through the sale ring become eligible for the A.T.B.A. Spring & Fall Sales Stakes which are run the following May and October as 2 years old with an estimated purse of \$75,000. (May - \$25,000 bonus paid to an Arizona-bred winner, October - \$100,000 bonus paid to an Arizona-bred winner)

During her juvenile racing season she won her 2017 Sales Stakes trial and came back to win the ATBA Fall Sales Stakes. The Fillies division purse was \$93,853. The winner's share was \$54,358.00 and the final time of the 6 furlongs race was 1:09.62. **Foggia** was purchased from the 2016 ATBA Sale for \$30,000 for the new owners Sawyer Cattle company. The colts & geldings division purse was \$91,837. The winner's share was \$54,632.00 and the final time of the 6 furlongs race was 1:10.52. **Fortified Effort** was purchased from the 2016 ATBA Sale for \$35,000 and began his juvenile racing career in Arizona in a trial, summering in Prairie Meadows and Arapahoe Park, returning to Arizona for the futurity. **Fortified Effort** is owned by Eikleberry, Matthews, Yother and Marvin Fleming was trained by Kevin Eikleberry. Is the Tax Court Biased in Favor of the IRS?

The U.S. Tax Court is a critically important institution. It is the most common forum in which taxpayers litigate federal tax disputes. The court frequently decides IRS assertions that the taxpayer understated the correct tax liability, resulting in a tax “deficiency”.

Many commentators argue that Tax Court judges are biased in favor of the IRS. Judges hear cases alone, without a jury. Many Tax Court judges have worked in the IRS Chief Counsel’s office or in the Tax Division of the U.S. Department of Justice. The tax court does not assign judges randomly to cases. The procedures are extremely burdensome. The burden of proof is “preponderance of the evidence,” which is a loose standard of evidence, and highly subjective. It means the IRS could win in 51% of its evidence is more convincing to the judge than the taxpayer’s.

The Tax Court makes budget requests to Congress’s tax-writing committees. In justifying its budget requests, the Tax Court invariably explains to congressional committees how well it is enforcing the tax laws.

A Tax Court judge Diane L. Kroupa, was indicted on tax evasion, conspiracy to defraud the United States, and obstruction charges, raising questions about whether any of her rulings could be vulnerable to challenge as a result. (Judge Kroupa abruptly resigned prior to the indictment without explanation. Her husband now divorced, was also indicted.) As a Tax Court judge, Kroupa heard and decided a wide range of cases, including some that came down against taxpayers in the horse and cattle industries. In October, 2016, she pleaded

guilty to conspiring to defraud the IRS and other crimes. When sentenced at a later date, she is likely to serve a significant prison term.

Another judge L. Paige Marvel, has also been harsh with respect to the horse industry. In a recent case, *Carmody v. Commissioner*, T.C. Memo 2016-225, Judge Marvel came down hard on a taxpayer’s efforts to run his horse racing venture profitably.

The taxpayer, Jerald Carmody, has owned race horses for more than 20 years, mainly as co-owner with others, and worked full-time as a sales representative for a helicopter company.

He owned lower priced horses which were actively raced in Washington State. Professional trainers were employed. He spent every day on his horse racing activity, researched horses that would be in competition, and searched for other horses to purchase.

He purchased and improved a five-acre property with a 4,000 square-foot barn, horse stalls, a 5,000 square-foot arena, indoor horse shelters, and nine pastures. He personally cleaned stalls and pastures.

Some of the horses won several races each, and one was the alltime race winner at Emerald Downs with 21 wins. Mr Carmody was named owner of the year at Emerald Downs. The races entered ranged in purses from \$8,000 to \$50,000.

During a 10-year period, the taxpayer’s losses were from \$16,064 to \$81,345, with no profit year. But there was income in each year, ranging from \$17,917 to \$128,068.



When horse retired from racing, they were sold or given away. Of 36 horses sold, there was a net gain on only eight of those sales.

Mr. Carmody had a horse racing bank account, but paid for expenses out of his personal account as well as the racing account. he kept a folder for each horse with various receipts and documents related to that horse.

Judge Mavel said that Mr. Carmody did not use any of his records to reduce losses or to achieve profitability. The court noted that Mr. Carmody had no written business plan, no budgets and no economic forecasts. "In fact, the record is devoid of any credible evidence that petitioner engaged in any meaningful financial management with respect to his horse racing activity."

The court said, "while a taxpayer need not maintain a sophisticated cost accounting system, the taxpayer should keep records that enable the taxpayer to cut expenses, generate or increase profits, or evaluate the overall performance of the operation."

The court also faulted Mr. Carmody for commingling his personal and horse racing finances. "This commingling of personal and horse activity funds is not indicative of a businesslike practice."

The court also noted that Mr. Carmody realized no profits in a 20-year period, and that "he contends that he suffered losses because he reinvested his gross receipts back into the horse racing activity and that he used his gross receipts to improve his

barns, arena, and other horse racing property. Petitioner's contentions are woefully insufficient to justify or even explain an unborken string of over 20 years of substantial losses."

The court concluded that the petitioner did not engage in his horse racing activity with the predominant, primary, or principal objective of making a profit.

The only silver lining in this case is that the judge rejected the IRS' accuracy-related penalties because the taxpayer had reasonably relied on his accountant's advise in taking the deductions.

One of the important lessons in this case is that taxpayers need to somehow review records so as to reduce expenses or enhance the possibility of generating income. It is important to keek track of expenses on a per-animal basis. And it is important to prepare financial statements,profit and loss projections, budggets, breakeven analyses, or marketing surveys, as the IRS considers these to be significant financial tools to aid in evaluating the overall performance of an operation.

SELECTING THE RIGHT BROODMARES

Decisions, decisions, decisions! What will we wear today? Where and what will we eat for lunch? We are constantly having to make choices from a large number of options.

Selection of broodmares is a critical stop if one is to become a successful horse breeder. While many mares will have a nice foal, the number of mares that produce a top-quality profitable foal is more limited.

Breeders need to have a thorough understanding of what they want to accomplish in the horse industry. If goals are too numerous and varied, it will be virtually impossible to establish a successful horse breeding business.

The more goals one has, the less emphasis and selection pressure that can be placed on each. Specific and well-defined goals aid one in selecting mare(s) that fit one's objectives.

Selection of broodmares needs to be based on genetic principles that are specific, well-defined and achievable. One does not use draft mares to produce race or cutting champions.

The most significant aids to selection of broodmares are items that can be observed, measured and evaluated.

A broodmare's performance record is most important. Has the mare successfully performed in events or activities that match your goals?

If you want to raise foals to compete in a specific type performance, the mare should have been shown successfully in those events. Performance ability is rather highly heritable. So, it is genetically transmitted from one generation to the next. Management factors, such as training or good nutrition, are not passed on to the next generation.

Conformation is also important since horses are athletic animals. Horses must stay sound if they are to perform successfully. Mares must have good skeletal conformation, especially feet and legs. Too often, individuals over-emphasize less important conformation traits, such as a pretty head or color, rather than soundness.

Poor conformation can result in unsoundnesses and impede performing certain actions. The more strenuous and difficult an action is, the more important conformation becomes.

If a mare has foals old enough, they should have performed well in selected events. By the time a mare has two or three foals old enough to perform, she may be 10 to 12 years old. Once mares get to be 16 years old or older, they are less likely to have foals every year. Older mares, even if they have had several successful performing foals, may not be a good investment. This is a reason to use a younger mare's performance record rather than waiting for her to have foals old enough to perform.

If a mare does not have foals old enough to perform, use her performance record for selection.

For mares to produce top-selling foals, they must have marketable pedigrees. Owners often place all their emphasis on pedigree selection. The mare may have a wonderful pedigree, but has never performed well in any event or produced a foal that has. She may also have serious conformational defects that she passes on to her foals. Such a mare is not a likely candidate to become a good broodmare. So pedigrees are of less genetic value than a mare's own performance record or that of her foals.

Selection of mares that will produce foals that meet your goals and have a positive impact on the horse industry requires careful thought and time.



HOW TO SELECT STALLIONS

Personal preference is fine when you are selecting the color of your car. But when selecting a stallion to breed to your mare, throw personal preference out the window. Your stallion selection decisions should be based only on sound genetic principles.

The object of horse breeding is for each generation to be superior to the preceding one. Selection permits certain individuals in a population to produce more offspring than others.

Using the best information to estimate breeding value, the horse breeder selects which stallions and mares will be the sires and dams of the next generation.

So, you need to consider three selection methods in choosing a stallion to breed to each mare. The primary selection criteria are phenotype, progeny test and pedigree.

Phenotypic selection considers a horse's performance record and conformation, which must be compared to that of other stallions. Phenotypic selection is valuable for medium to highly heritable traits. There is evidence that most performance ability is in this range of heritability.

Selection based on the stallion's performance will be ineffective for lowly heritable traits, particularly if environmental influences are not taken into account.

To use phenotypic selection, the stallion must be old enough to express his performance ability. So, a young stallion with no performance record is at a disadvantage.

Progeny test considers the performance merit of a stallion's foals to predict the stallion's breeding value. It can be the most accurate selection method. With a large number of foals, you can rank stallions with near certainty, even when the trait has a fairly low heritability. This selection may be biased by preferential treatment of certain offspring or culling of inferior ones.

The stallion must be old enough to have foals of performance age. So, most stallions will be 7 years old or older before they have 2-year-old performers. The performance records of parents and other

relatives are evaluated to estimate the breeding merit of the stallion in pedigree selection. Some horse breeders over-emphasize pedigree selection. It is most valuable in young stallions for traits not yet expressed, such as performance.

In pedigree selection, the most emphasis should be placard on a stallion's close relatives, since they have more genes in common with the stallion. Great-great grandsires are not as valuable as the sire, the dam or half-siblings. To be successful, breeders should only consider the first two generations.

Pedigrees must be considered for future marketing. But, rarely should the pedigree be given as much emphasis as the stallion's own performance record.

Some mare owners think that a stallion will solve all their mare's faults. Owners need to be objective in evaluating each mare and her breeding value in the process of stallion selection.

They can use a complimentary breeding method. If a mare has bad knees or tends to produce foals with bad knees, she should be bred to a stallion that has good knee conformation and has sired foals with good knees.

A mare that has no performance record or has not produced any foals to perform would be bred to a stallion which is a successful performer. If old enough, his foals also should have performed well in desired events. Pedigree selection can aid the mare owner in these situations. The mare's pedigree, reflected in the first two generations, should represent families that are successful performers (sire/produce performers). Mares that have not performed or produced performing foals may not produce a world's champion from such mating, but she could produce a foal that performs well.

The best method of stallion selection uses a combination of the three selection methods. When a stallion has a large number of performance age foals, little is gained by including other information in the evaluation of the stallion's breeding value.

HEROISM AT SAN LUIS REY



As with most tragedies there are examples of courage that flash to the surface in split seconds when all seems lost, when circumstances overwhelm, when seemingly ordinary people become super human and accomplish the impossible.

Some are born heroes; some are born on the spot. No amount of training or preparation can predict who will emerge as a hero until the time comes. Captain Sullenberger was a hero that was well trained and experienced. When thrown in the crucible he did the right thing. The proper course of action is not always apparent in an emergency. Decision-making is split second and miscalculations unforgiving.

There is no doubt the conflagration that occurred at San Luis Rey Downs on December 7th, 2017 was such an occasion. A time when ordinary souls, forged by fire, accomplished feats beyond mortal expectations.

While I have no doubt that there were numerous feats of selfless heroism that occurred as the Armageddon of San Luis Rey unfolded, I am compelled to note one such story of which I have personal knowledge.

The barn of Edward Freeman was one of the first to be completely destroyed by fire. Mr. Freeman was away on a family visit to his native England. He departed comfortable in the knowledge his barn was in the good care of barn manager and exercise rider Casandra Branick. Like most mornings Casandra woke at 4 am and arrived at the Freeman barn a short time later to oversee a crew of eight grooms as they fed, watered, trained and exercised 17 Thoroughbred Racehorses. Another was at an equine clinic.

What began as a normal day soon turned horrible beyond imagination. Shortly after 11am, Branick, noticed telltale signs of fire on the hilltops to the east. Acting quickly, she alerted her crew and began tranquilizing her charges in anticipation of an evacuation. She ordered bales of hay be watered down and began loading feed and water tubs on the van. Contacting Freeman in England, she recommended evacuating the horses. Freeman concurred and advised his owners of the situation and vowed to take responsibility for the potentially hazardous decision.

With a green light from her boss, Branick began loading her charges. She sent the first load to Del Mar Race Track before anyone there knew of the emergency. She even had the foresight to send ulcer medication in case it was needed.

This was only the beginning of a long day that would not end for another 30 hours. As the day progressed, Branick was able to load her remaining horses on various vans throughout the afternoon. Some of these animals were

by nature, high strung and difficult to deal with. The fact that she was able to coerce them onto vans that they were clearly resistant to is amazing enough! That this was accomplished without benefit of lip-chains or lead ropes and in one case with only a leather belt is simply miraculous.

As the day progressed with her horses dispersed to three locations she turned to save her goat and another from a neighboring barn. As she exited the track the police laughed at the two frightened animals squealing in the back seat.

With the goats delivered to safety she attempted to return to the track but was blocked by law enforcement. Noticing a veterinarian on foot attempting gain access to the track, this dynamo from New Jersey once again took charge. Instructing the vet to get in she drove her car up on the median and manage to enter the facility where numerous injured horses were then humanely euthanized.

Returning to the horror of stampeding horses, some on fire, Cas Branick proceeded to render help to others. She helped load horses with the aid of fallen palm fronds. The barn directly behind her lost at least three horses and a trainer who suffered severe burn was evacuated to a hospital where she remains in a medically induced coma.

My second hand telling of these feats, no doubt leaves much to be desired. But what I do know, is that the two horses I own in partnership with Edward Freeman are alive and well. As day turned to night Casandra Branick never stopped. Speaking to her through the night and into the next morning I know she attempted to provide clothing and comfort to her grooms ...all of which lost every earthly possession to the fire. They were without money, documents and clothing. She, herself was without money or medication.

As she attempted to leave the area later that night, she was met with roadblocks. Eventually, she was able to get to her house and for the first time get something to drink. Despite my admonishment to go to bed, she once again set out to inventory her horses at various locations in the area.

I have no doubt my narrative does little justice to the "rest of the story" as Paul Harvey would have said, but I know enough! As a veteran and retired airline pilot, if I had to choose someone to go battle with it would be this 110lb. package of dynamite that looks at fear with contempt and the impossible as just a momentary speed bump.

FROM "LONE WOLF" TO "ONE OF THE BOYS"

On July 12, 2012, Washington-bred STRANGER AMONG US joined our herd of retirees at Equine Encore Foundation's 120 acre horse farm west of Tucson. He was delivered personally by his owner & trainer, Laurie Jones. Laurie had done her homework. Before delivering this bay gelding who foaled April 14, 2000, she had visited the farm and checked out the property and our residents to assure herself that her horse would be in good hands.

He was strictly a "blue collar" racehorse. After breaking his maiden at the California fairs in Solano on July 17, 2003 and running a couple of times in New Mexico, he found a home at Yavapai Downs and the Arizona fairs. Although he was not Breeders' Cup material, he amassed an enviable record of 19 wins, 10 seconds and 13 thirds in 66 starts. His last race was at Rillito Racetrack in Tucson on March 23, 2012, and he "lit the board" in his final start, finishing third.

For the five plus years he has been with us, Stranger has lived with the same group of geldings. They are: Brax who was lightly raced in New Mexico, Ghostly Dance who earned \$133,330 on the New Mexico tracks and Touch My Abs who was a \$135,000 yearling purchase in Keeneland and who ran 10 of his 20 starts in California. Brax is a beautiful chestnut, Ghostly Dance is a bay with some "chrome" and Touch My

Abs is a gorgeous gray. For some reason these three shunned Stranger who is a dark brown/bay from the day he arrived. We have two large pasture feeders in their area, and Stranger has always eaten from one feeder all by himself while the other three eat together from the other feeder.



A few weeks ago I found Stranger pawing and then going down and rolling. As you horsemen and women know, this is never a good sign. His three pasture mates were standing around him. I quickly grabbed a halter & lead rope and some Banamine. After giving him the Banamine, we

started walking. He frequently tried to do down again, and his "roommates" would nip at him and encourage him to keep walking. After what seemed like miles of walking, he passed gas, pooped and became interested in eating. For the first time ever, he joined the other three horses at "their" feeder and was welcomed by them.

Since that time, Stranger has been accepted and almost never dines alone! Did the other three recognize the symptoms of the dreaded colic and empathize with their formerly excluded companion? Did they think he might be leaving them? We need a "Horse Whisperer" to ferret out the truth, but whatever clicked in their equine minds was a good thing and STRANGER IS NOW ONE OF THE BOYS!

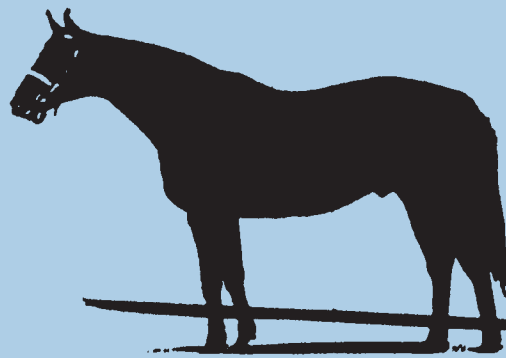

PEDIGREE CROSS INDEX

This Pedigree Cross Index allows a breeder to nick, inbreed or outcross his broodmares by easy reference. Indexed are the names of sires and dams included within the first three generations of all the stallions in the 2018 Stallion Directory.

Example: AFFIRMED - Charlie Barley, Mystery Storm, Peteski

In the above example, Affirmed appears in one of the first 3 generations of all the stallions listed after him.

Suppose a breeder has a mare that is a granddaughter of Mr. Prospector or has crosses of that sire in a mare's pedigree. He may want to breed her to a stallion with Northern Dancer blood to take advantage of the Northern Dancer--Mr. Prospector nick. By looking up "Northern Dancer" in this index, he can quickly see all the stallions in this register that have Northern Dancer appearing in one of the first three generations of their pedigrees.

If a breeder's mare is a granddaughter of Seattle Slew, he may wish to inbreed to that stallion and thereby get more of Seattle Slew's makeup in the foal. By checking "Seattle Slew" in the index, the breeder can readily find all the advertised stallions that have Seattle Slew in their pedigrees.

What if a breeder's mare is already inbred or linebred? She might have 2 or 3 crosses of Deputy Minister in her first four generations for example. The breeder may want to make sure the stallion he chooses for his mare has no Deputy Minister or no Deputy Minister up close in his pedigree. By looking up "Deputy Minister" in the index, he can readily see the stallions in this Stallion Register he should avoid for his mare.

Keep your Stallions progeny eligible!

Stallion owners:

Any stallion that stands the entire breeding season in Arizona, and files a copy of the The Jockey Club Report of Mares bred for that breeding season with the ATBA office, that stallion (s) offspring will be eligible to race in the Stallion Stakes Derby.

What this means to you as a stallion owner:

All 2018 foals of Arizona Stallions (standing the full 2015 breeding season in Arizona) will be eligible to enter the 2020 Stallion Stakes Derby. This should create an exciting race as there are no early nominations, or late fees.

Stallion owners must send a copy of the Jockey Club Report of Mares Bred to the ATBA office each breeding season. This is mandatory if your stallions offspring is to have the opportunity to participate.

Foals need not be Arizona-bred, but must be by a stallion standing the full season in Arizona and a copy of the Report of Mares bred on file with the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders office.

**The Arizona Stallion Stakes Derby is a restricted race
for the offspring of Arizona Stallions.**

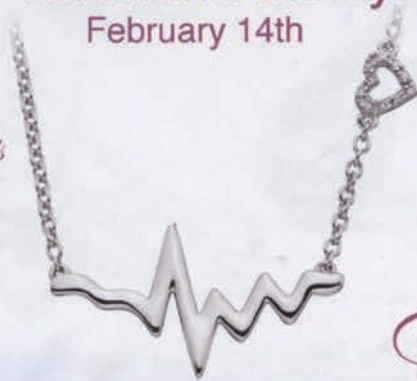
