Saying Good Bye to the Boss Lady

YVONNE LAURE KUNZ Nov. 25 1936 - Oct 1, 2019



Yvonne peacefully departed this world Tuesday, October 1, 2019 in Phoenix, Az.

In 1992 she started as the Editor of the ATBA magazine. She was tucked away in her small office, in the back of the Rizzonico's Vet Clinic across the street from Turf Paradise. There she produced the Breeders magazine and assisted with the "Best Little Sale In The West" for two years.

Due to the resignation of the Executive Director, midterm, and her keen eye for detail, Yvonne was asked to step in and take over the reigns of the director's position. She turned the board down for the position, but agreed to run things through the horse sale and until the position could be filed. The board was so pleased with the job she did through the sale, they voted her in as Executive Director in July. This not giving her the option of a no answer again.

In 1994, she helped shepherded in SB1208 which established \$40,000 stallion award fund and guaranteed the breeders award fund at least \$8000,000. That established extra money paid to any Arizona Bred finishing first, in any race in Arizona.

In 1995, she was instrumental in the passage of SB1384 which helped secure the future of Rillito Park through simulcasting. In 1996 she received the Julep Cup award for outstanding service in the Thoroughbred Industry. Which was much deserved. She loved this industry and helping the small guys on the backside. 2004 she helped the Retired Racehorse Act get passed and establishing the fund that saved retired racehorse and provided them a new career of the track. 2008 Governor Brewer swept our Breeders fund and left us unfunded Again, Yvonne went back to work with the help of Marvin Fleming and Elaine Arena, the ATBA lobbyist and secured \$250,000 from the state budget to our breeders fund beginning in July 2012.

She accomplished many great things for this organization. (Which she would never take credit for) her favorite one has been the growth of the Arizona Breeders Festival. Where it has grown from just over \$82,000 of purse distribution in 1993 to \$222,000 paid out in purse today. The largest day Turf Paradise has in purse distribution through out the season.

Yvonne married Kent Kunz on October 14, 1965 and raised four kids in Idaho. Yvonne and Kent found a love of Thoroughbred race horse and have enjoyed 50 years of spending time together with their horses. she loved watching their two year olds develop in to some thing special.

Throughout her, life Yvonne could be found cooking for her family, entertaining company, traveling, caring for her horses, rooting for her favorite college teams on TV and spending time with her family. One of her greatest joys was spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Yvonne was known for her smile, her sense of humor, always knowing exactly what to say and choosing to be happy even in adversity.

This entire organization is grateful for her dedicated service from 1992 to June 2012. She will be greatly missed!


The 1st running of the Las Vegas Ranch Stakes Who's the Diva Now


2 year-old rallied to win the fillies division of the 2018 ATBA Fall Sales Stakes Futurity

THE IMPORTANCE OF WRITTEN CONTRACTS WITH TRAINERS

We all know that recordkeeping is important for tax purposes, as well as for keeping track of day-to-day developments in one's horse activities - whether in racing or breeding. One area that is often neglected, however, pertains to written contracts with trainers.

Written contracts are important with trainers not only to protect the parties from unexpected legal liability, but also to provide documentary evidence in the case of an IRS audit. Auditors will ask to see business records associated with the horse venture, and often revenue agents find it incomprehensible that anyone involved in the horse business would not have written contracts with trainers.

The contract should make it clear that the trainer is undertaking the training of the animals listed in the agreement and/or to educate the owner on how to train them. The agreement should specify the terms and conditions of payment, and incidental services, like boarding, grooming, labor, transportation, veterinary expenses, etc., that might involve additional charges.

The horses to be trained should be listed, with the name of the current insurer, if applicable, the insurer's emergency phone number, a disclosure of the horse's vices or unique habits, and other pertinent information.

Under state laws, the trainer can impose a livestock lien to enforce unpaid boarding costs, and this fact should be mentioned in the contract. Enforcement of a lien for unpaid bills, however, is an undesirable last resort, and involves filing a case in court, with associated legal fees and delays.

The contract should have language specifying that the trainer will perform all services in accordance with generally accepted professional standards, and that the trainer will exercise reasonable care for the protection of the horses, and will educate and train the horses and/or owners to the best of his or her ability. There should be a clause pertaining to routine horse care requirements, or special needs.

For the trainer, the contract will set forth an "assumption of risk" clause to make it clear that he or she is not liable for injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting in the inherent risks of equine activities. To avoid any misunderstanding, the contract should state that the trainer cannot and does not guarantee or predict the success of the training program, since this depends somewhat on the individual physical and mental ability of each horse.

Trainers will always want a statement that each horse will be delivered to the trainer's facility free from transmissible diseases, and must be effectively wormed, and have current immunizations prior to arrival.

Trainers usually want the right to terminate the agreement on short notice for any reason, including the animals' poor health or unsoundness, dangerous propensities, or other conditions that make the horse unsuitable for training. Likewise, the agreement should state that the owner may terminate the agreement for any reason.

There should be a clause authorizing the trainer to obtain emergency care if the trainer is unable to contact the owner.

Another important clause desired by trainers is a statement that the trainer will not be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death or injury arising out of the boarding or training of the animal except in the event of willful negligence.

It is important to ascertain whether the trainer has public liability, accidental injury, theft or equine mortality insurance that might pertain to horses boarded at his or her stable.

You should retain signed copies of the agreement (not blank copies), for if you are audited the revenue agent will want to see them.

For racehorse contracts the trainer may be designated as an authorized agent with authority to decide which races to enter, including claiming races, and which jockey shall ride the horse. There should be provision for the owner to have the right to require another jockey or his choice, and the option to withdraw the horse from or not enter it in a particular race, or to direct the trainer to enter the horse in a particular race.



NTRA Legislative News

Three year Racehorse Depreciation Extension Passed by both Houses of Congress

A key provision that extends three-year tax depreciation for all racehorses through 2020 passed the Senate by a vote of 71-23 earlier today. The racehorse provision was passed by the House of Representatives on Tuesday by a vote of 297-120 as part of a larger tax package.

"We appreciate the Senate's work to include this important provision," said NTRA President and Chief Executive Officer Alex Waldrop. "We especially applaud the efforts of Leader McConnell, who does so much to support Kentucky's signature industry."

Uniform three-year racehorse depreciation was among numerous tax provisions across many industries that either expired at the beginning of 2018 or this year, or were set to expire as of Jan. 1, 2020. The bill reinstates the 3-year schedule for all racehorses retroactive to 2018 and through 2020.

The provision allows taxpayers to depreciate, on a three-year schedule, racehorses 24 months of age and

younger when purchased and placed into service, as opposed to a seven-year schedule.

Three-year racehorse depreciation was most recently available to the industry in 2017 but Congress did not renew it for 2018 as part of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) passed in December 2017. The TCJA did include 100% bonus depreciation and a \$1 million Sec. 179 expense allowance for qualified depreciable property, two important investment incentives that lessened the need for three-year depreciation in many cases. However, three-year depreciation continues to be a beneficial option for many racehorse owners, especially racing partnerships with multiple passive owners, as it better aligns deductions with corresponding income opportunities on an annual basis.

Maintaining the three-year recovery period for racehorse purchases has been a top legislative priority for the NTRA federal legislative team since the provision's initial enactment as part of the 2008 Farm Bill.



Digital Certificate - FAQs

1. How will I receive my Digital Certificate(s)?

When you log on to your Jockey Club Interactive Registration account, you will see an option under DIGITAL CERTIFICATES labeled CERTIFICATE MANAGEMENT that will display the certificates currently assigned to your Interactive Registration account.

2. Who is assigned the Digital Certificate?

Digital Certificates are assigned to a Certificate Manager, a person or entity authorized to control the disposition of a Digital Certificate. The Certificate Manager may or may not be the owner of the horse.

3. How will I forward my Digital Certificate to a sales company, racetrack, or other entity that requires the Certificate of Foal Registration?

The Certificate Manager will be able to assign the certificate to another party by selecting the appropriate entity or person, clicking the button that says "Assign Certificate," and then following the prompts to complete the assignment.

4. How will I know when a Digital Certificate has been assigned to my account?

An email notification will be sent shortly after a digital certificate(s) has been assigned to your Interactive Registration account.

5. Will all of my horses be issued a Digital Certificate?

Foals of 2018 and after will be issued Digital Certificates.

6. What if a mistake was made when assigning a Digital Certificate?

If a mistake was made when assigning a Digital Certificate the assignor should contact The Jockey Club for assistance at inquiries@jockeyclub.com.

7. How can I determine the current Digital Certificate Manager of a Thoroughbred?

When you log on to your Jockey Club Interactive Registration account, you will see an option under **REGISTRATION** labeled **CHECK REGISTRATION STATUS** that will display the current Digital Certificate Manager for foals of 2018 and later.

8. Does the ownership data recorded with the assignment of a Digital Certificate prove title to the horse?

No. The Jockey Club is a pedigree registry for Thoroughbred horses, not an ownership or title registry. Accordingly, any information presented by The Jockey Club concerning the "owner" of a horse is based solely upon information provided by others and is in no way warranted or otherwise offered by The Jockey Club as being a representation of who the actual owner or title holder of a particular Thoroughbred is.

TRPB going digital: Lip tattoos to be discontinued by 2020

Effective January 1, 2020, any Thoroughbred that has not been previously lip tattooed and is making its first lifetime start in a recognized pari-mutuel race, must have the TRPB Digital Tattoo in order to be correctly identified in the paddock and permitted to race.



The transition to the TRPB Digital Tattoo follows the recent requirement by The Jockey Club for a horse to be microchipped as part of the registration process. All foals from 2017 onward have a listed microchip on their Jockey Club papers.

The Association of Racing Commissioners International (ARCI) passed a model rule regarding Digital Tattoos. The model rule states, effective January 1, 2020, the racing secretary shall ensure that the registration certificates for all Thoroughbred horses that were foaled in 2018 or thereafter have a Digital Tattoo prior to entry in a race.

In essence, the Digital Tattoo is an electronic validation of the identity of a horse performed by a trained TRPB technician. The technician will use a scanner to read the horse's microchip and the microchip number will hyperlink to electronic registration information. After fully examining the markings and foal photos contained in the horse's electronic record, the technician will confirm the identity of the horse standing in front of him or her and upload a selection of digital pictures documenting the horse's markings to The Jockey Club's database. The TRPB technician will then place a digital stamp on the electronic certificate of registration. This Digital Tattoo will indicate that the TRPB has verified the identity of the horse and uploaded updated digital photographs to the breed registry's database.

Digital tattoo technicians

The TRPB currently has 30+ tattoo technicians operating throughout the United States and Canada who are fully trained in Digital Tattooing and are prepared to scan, photograph and certify your Thoroughbred for identification purposes. Until the end of 2019, Thoroughbreds will also be lip tattooed in order to use that identification throughout their racing career. Most technicians are capable of administering both the Digital Tattoos and the lip tattoos.

In order to have your Thoroughbred tattooed, you must possess a valid Certificate of Foal Registration issued by The Jockey Club with the horse's microchip number on the papers. There is a US\$80/CA\$100 (plus tax) charge for each horse identified, plus any expenses for a technician's travel exceeding reasonable and customary practice. Any thoroughbred whose markings are at variance with its Jockey Club Certificate of Foal Registration, or if the microchip does not read correctly, will be rejected for tattooing. In 2020, all fees still apply. Any Thoroughbred rejected for tattooing must receive a corrected certificate before receiving a Digital Tattoo and may have to be re-DNA typed for verification.



A MARE'S ESTRUS CYCLE OCCURS WHEN THE LENGTH OF DAYLIGHT IS LONG, AND NATURAL ESTROUS (ENTIRE CYCLE) BEGINS IN THE SPRING. HOWEVER, MARES CAN BE PLACED UNDER ARTIFICIAL LIGHTS AS EARLY AS DECEMBER TO PREPARE THEM FOR THE BEGINNING OF BREEDING SEASON IN FEBRUARY. year, only 20 of them will make it to the starting gate in the 2020 Kentucky Derby. A great deal of work goes into producing a healthy, thriving munchkin. The process begins long before a thoroughbred racehorse is ever born.

Breeding racehorses is as much of a science as it is an art and breeders and horse owners spend countless hours studying pedigrees and analyzing the "best" sires to send their mares to. Some people consider figures such as the "dosage index," which is a mathematical statistic to determine the projected distances progeny will best perform at. It takes into account several generations of a horse's pedigree and the performance of the family. Other people use the TrueNicks system to plan their matings. This system

assigns a grade from A++ to F based on the degree of affinity between the sire and broodmare sire.

Some people use their years of experience to help them decide which stallion they believe will produce a quality foal with their mare. Many other factors besides mathematical figures go into selecting a stallion including size of the mare and stallion, stud fee, performance of mare and stallion, previous matings, etc.

For instance, a breeder with a small mare would likely choose a tall, large boned stallion to breed to in hopes of putting some size into the foal. A breeder may chose to mate his sprint type mare to a sprint type stallion in hope of producing a speedster, or may chose to mate to a classic distance type runner to increase stamina influence. Sometimes the horses with the highest dosages indexes and most prestigious family lines don't live up to expectations. Sometimes horses with obscure pedigrees go on to do great things on the racetrack. That is what makes breeding an art.

Once a mare owner selects a stallion, they submit the mare to the breeding farm to be accepted. The stud farm can accept or reject the mare after considering her pedigree, race record, and progeny. Some stallions cover over 100 mares a season, and as with anything, some are in higher demand than others. The term "booked full," means no more mares will be accepted to breed to a particular stallion.

Mares are carefully monitored using ultrasound technology and "teasing" to determine when ovulation is most likely to occur, and the mating should occur as close to the end of the heat cycle as possible. When a mare is in estrus (the phase of the estrous cycle when she is in heat, a period of maximum sexual receptivity), there will be evidence of one or more follicles on her ovaries.

A mare's estrus cycle occurs when the length of daylight is long, and natural estrous (entire cycle) begins in the spring. However, mares can be placed under artificial lights as early as December to prepare them for the beginning of breeding season in February.

The covering process varies depending on the stallion and behavior of the mare. Trained personnel handle both the stallion and mare during the mating process, and many times mares are restrained and protected to prevent injury. An experienced stallion will cover a mare in a few minutes. Other stallions are quirky and may balk at certain types of mares (some stallions will not cover grey mares for instance). It's worth noting that every single cover has to be a live cover. There is no artificial insemination with registered Thoroughbreds.

A pregnancy can be diagnosed using ultrasound about 14 days after ovulation. If a mare does not conceive, she will come back into heat 14-16 days after the end of the last heat period. Sometimes mares need more than once to be bred, but with any luck and skill, it only takes one time. With quality care and some help from Mother Nature, a foal will be born 11 months later.

Good Luck this year with your methods of choosing the right stallion for your mares!

Any stallion that stands the entire breeding season in Arizona, and files a copy of the The Jockey Club Report of Mares bred for that breeding season with the ATBA office, that stallion (s) offspring will be eligible to race in the Stallion Stakes Derby.

WHAT THIS MEANS TO YOU AS A STALLION OWNER.

All 2020foals of Arizona Stallions (standing the full 2018 breeding season in Arizona) will be eligible to enter the 2022 Stallion Stakes derby. This should create an exciting race as there are no early nominations, or late fees.

Stallion owners must send a copy of the Jockey Club Report of Mares Bred to the ATBA office each breeding season. This is mandatory if your stallions offspring is to have the opportunity to participate.

Foals need not be Arizona-bred, but must be by a stallion standing the full season in Arizona and a copy of the Report of Mares bred on file with the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders office.

The Arizona Stallion Stakes Derby is a restricted race for the offspring of Arizona Stallions.
