





BUYING SALE YEARLINGS PLAIN AND SIMPLE

W

Whether you are a new to yearling buying or a veteran, you are on the threshold of a fascinating and sometimes magical journey. It is hard for those who have been around awhile to explain the enduring passion that horse people have for a life filled with horses and horse business. It clearly has much to do with the beauty and magnetism of the horse themselves. But the lasting appeal goes even deeper, to a personal level, as the horse business provides a stimulating arena for enriching or living a life. In short, although the horse business is about the horse, it is also about each individual's hopes and dreams, struggles and failures, and the great joy and redemption that comes with occasional triumphs of the highest intensity. Few humans endeavors can transport a soul from the bottom of the deepest valley to the top of the highest peak, sometimes in a single day.

The trick is to plan for success carefully and intelligently enough that you can enjoy the moment, survive the peaks and valleys, and still stick around for the long ride. Staying in place

over time is key, because no matter how any single year plays out, the industry's kaleidoscope turns on January 1st and a whole new vista of opportunity emerges, allowing everyone still standing to pursue their goals and dreams once again.

SETTING YOURSELF UP FOR SUCCESS

The cornerstone of long-term success rests on realizing that the horse business is also a people business. Treating others the way you want to be treated

yourself builds trust and lasting relationships that will help you achieve long-term goals. No one can make it on his or her own, and achieving consistent results over many years requires a lot of help from your friends. It is also important to remember that, given enough time, what goes around usually comes around.

Beyond that, only six things really matter: (1) LUCK (2) Knowing what you're doing (3) Hiring trustworthy help who have a track record of success in the industry (4) Having enough

money to execute your plan for success (5) Maintaining discipline and perseverance; and (6) more luck.

The ability to spot a well-balanced athlete, along with acquiring well-balanced athlete by following the sales horses you evaluate through their racing careers, will help you make the most of that part of the puzzle which you control. As in any business, knowledge is power. If you separate fact from false or unsubstantiated beliefs, you can position yourself so that good luck can run over you. For yearling buyers, the ever-present and powerful role of luck is a constant companion. This is not a bad thing for inexperienced buyers, because it levels the playing field and allows everyone to play the game. Sometimes "beginner's luck" can be very powerful.

START WITH A SOUND BUSINESS PLAN

Plan thoughtfully and specifically so that you can still succeed with less than average luck, and can prosper if good fortune embraces you beyond expectation.

As in establishing any business, the single most important prerequisite for success is making sure that you are sufficiently capitalized relative to your objectives, and are not risking money that you cannot afford to lose. Construct conservative cash flow charts

that include all keep and interest charges, and be sure to have sufficient capital for the first four or five years while you wait for returns.

Finally, don't rely only on yourself. Put the very best people in place at all levels who are experienced, competent, sensible, reliable, and honest.

APPROACHING THE SALE SCENE

Once you have your business plan, your money and your team in place the fun begins. SO DOES THE WORK!

Most seasonal veterans feel a surge of excitement when they learn that "the catalogs are out! Each book shuffles a fresh deck, and deals a new grab bag of optimism and opportunity.

Just like when the hawker at a race track entrance hold up the day's program and shouts out "I've got all the winners right here! So too, are most of the sport's future stars embedded between the covers of the auction catalogs. The trick, of course, is sorting them out so that you can land on the most promising prospects.

This adventure is not a science. Human reason alone is not adequate for the task. A mixture of reason and art is required, with a large dose of instinct or intuition thrown in.

Seeing the horse in front of you for its true potential for the athlete that is really is (or is not) depends on your ability to focus on facts rather than smoke and mirrors.

Furthermore, as you work to sort out the yearlings, your chance of purchasing quality racehorse will be greatly increased if you identify and understand the many false beliefs that are perpetuated at the sale each year by people who are poorly informed or otherwise misguided.


Personal success comes from working hard to empower yourself enough to make your own mistakes to learn from them, and to persevere in pursuit of your own dream

Near perfect individual like Secretariat don't come around very often. Virtually every yearling can be faulted in some way, especially if it is an observer's nature to find fault. The most important sales assessment task is to try to figure out whether or not a particular fault is likely to compromise future racing success. Therefore, learning to properly evaluate a horse's movement as an athlete is an essential skill to acquire. So, too, is learning to observe, describe, and evaluate the degree of the fault.

Bulding a Foundation of Foot Care in Foals

Among the many factors that determine the success of a foal as a sale yearling or a mature athlete are management decisions about its feet and limbs during its first four months of life.

Because a solid foundation for its performance in the future begins with foot care in the foal, many leading breeding farms use programs that combine the skill of a veterinarian (with an interest in podiatry) with the skill of a farrier. This joint venture allows an earlier and more accurate diagnosis, treatment and prognosis of foot problems. Although this type of preventive program may be time-consuming, if it corrects a foot or limb problem and increases the athletic potential of even one animal, it is a worthwhile investment.

EVALUATING THE FOAL

Careful observation and record-keeping begins at birth and continues throughout the foal's development. The physical appearance of a foal's limbs and feet at birth should be recorded, along with changes that occur as he or she grows. When examining the feet and limbs, an imaginary dot system works nicely. Starting

at the ground surface of the foot, an imaginary dot is placed on the toe, coronary band, fetlock, top of cannon bone, knee, top of knee and top of forearm. By connecting these dots with an imaginary line, it is easy to see if and/or where a deformity exists. In the ideal situation, the dots should form a straight line when viewed from the front.

Next, view the foal from the side. Check to see if the coronary band is level, or parallel with the ground, and if the hoof and pastern angles are the same--not broken forward or broken backward. Also, any swelling of the limb or joint should be noted.

Finally, watch the foal walk toward and away from you. Because this can be difficult, as they seldom walk straight, walk the mare along a fence or wall and let the foal follow. This part of the examination checks for any lameness that may be present, the arc of the foot flight, how the foot breaks over at the toe and especially how the foot contact the ground. Foals should be observed walking each time their feet are trimmed.

TRIMMING THE FOAL

Unless your veterinarian suggest otherwise, foals should have their first trim around a month of age and remain on a monthly schedule. In these first few months of life, more attention should be paid to the structural integrity of the foot (its size and mass) than to its

cosmetic appearance. The goal is to promote the growth of thick, durable hoof wall: ensure maximum sole depth to protect the white line and coffin bone; and establish a strong heel base. These three factors--strong hoof wall, adequate sole and solid heel--are vital for future soundness.

In most cases, all that is necessary to trim foals that are kept on a monthly schedule is a hoof pick and rasp. The frog is left untouched to serve as a protective mechanism, absorbing and dissipating concussive forces. Since the sole of a foal is extremely thin, it is also left untouched to provide protection to immature developing structures in the foot. Removing as little hoof wall as possible and simply shaping and smoothing causes it to become thicker and more durable.

The object in trimming foals is to achieve balance, that is, to encourage the foot to land flat, or contact the ground evenly. Careful thought should be given before using corrective trimming procedures on a foal with a limb deformity. Since the problem is generally a conformation deformity of structure above the foot, changing the balance of the foot may lead to other problems. Careful examination of a foal's limbs at birth and throughout its first few months--along with accurate record-keeping, and a good working relationship between you, your veterinarian and your farrier--are the keys to a sound, athletic horse in the future.

THE MATERIAL PARTICIPATION TEST CAN TRICK TAXPAYERS

Taxpayers who are audited in connection with their horse or livestock activities often are questioned on the issue known in tax law as the “material participation test.” Under this legal test, you are permitted to deduct losses against outside salary and wages only if, among other things, you “materially participate” in the activity. Many duties related to owning horses or livestock, such as training, showing or racing the animals, are delegated to qualified experts, and sometimes the IRS will question the validity of your own participation in decision-making in an effort to say you have failed to meet the material participation.

This usually happens in the context of operations that involve a partnership or joint venture. For instance, a horseman in California entered into a partnership with four other partners to purchase a brood mare. One partner was the managing partner and was responsible for maintaining the books and records of the partnership and for paying all expenses. The partnership made decisions by majority vote of all partners. The brood mare was bred to a number of stallions, but the partnership generated losses over a period of seven years.

The U.S. Tax Court denied the horseman the right to write off these losses against his income from a trucking business he owned because it held he did not materially participate in the partnership. Accordingly, his losses were limited by the passive income rule of Section 469 of the IRS Code and could not be used to offset his non passive income.

This case illustrates the importance of obtaining advance legal guidance whenever you enter into a partnership if you intend to write off possible losses against non passive income sources. The material participation test is something you must plan on meeting and complying with, and it is not something to be treated lightly. As a general rule, a taxpayer will be regarded as materially participating in a partnership if he or she is involved in the operation of the activity on a “regular, continuous and substantial” basis.

What does this mean? A threshold requirement for meeting this test is that the taxpayer has participated in the activity for more than 100 hours during each taxable year. A taxpayer can establish the extent of his or her participation by any reasonable means including “the identification of service performed over a period of time and the approximate number of hours spent performing such services during such period, based on appointment books, calendars or narrative summaries.” But in the case referenced above, the only evidence the taxpayer presented at trial regarding participation in the partnership was his uncorroborated testimony that he

spent hundreds of hours researching potential stallions to bred with the brood mare and a calendar log that reflected 15 entries for phone calls he made relating to the partnership. Even with that meager evidence, the number of hours shown was less than 100 hours per year.

The kinds of activities that a taxpayer should be able to document during each year may include the following.

- 1 Consulting with advisers, other breeders and veterinarians
- 2 Attending horse shows, horse sales or races;
- 3 Seeing horses being worked
- 4 Keeping business records
- 5 Discussing matters with one’s spouse and other partners
- 6 Implementing or formulating business plans and revising them
- 7 Reviewing finances, making cost projections and making disbursements
- 8 Speaking with vendors on the telephone or in person;
- 9 Talking to potential customers
- 10 Grooming horses and tending to the physical labor that is part of proper animal husbandry
- 11 Performing other task and decision-making functions

But it is imperative that records be kept to reflect the number of hours involved, and material must be 100 or more hours per year.

In my opinion, the material participation test does not apply to ordinary stallion syndications, which are not partnerships in the technical sense but instead are co-ownership entities where each owner has a fractional interest in the stallion. Still, the IRS has been known to challenge taxpayers on the material participation test in these contexts. I think part of the reason is that some revenue agents are confused as to the application of this provision of tax law.

It is important to keep in mind that the material participation test is supplemental to the overall IRS regulations concerning the objective intention to make a profit. Even if you can prove material participation in a horse activity, the IRS could find that the venture was merely a hobby by arguing that you do not have the overall intention to be engaged in a trade or business for profit, or that there are other elements, such as recreation, lack of reliance on experts or insufficient showing of the amount of time in the venture, that fail to satisfy IRS regulations on the subject.

AKIFUMI KATO'S REMARKABLE RACING RECORD EARNS JOCKEY OF THE WEEK HONORS

Akifumi Kato's amazing record of posting at least on win each year for 50 consecutive years (1972-2021) was such a unique achievement it earned the journeyman Jockey of the Week Honors. This award, which is voted on by a panel of racing experts, is for jockeys who are members of the Jockey's Guild, the organization which represents more than 950 active riders in the United States as well as retired and permanently disabled jockeys.

Currently riding at Turf Paradise the unique milestone was celebrated on January 8th when Kato won the 5th race aboard She's A Lady Griz which was also his 69th birthday. The win was made even more special as the winner is trained by Kato's daughter, Kaylyn Kato.

Kato was born in Japan to a Jockey turned trainer. After winning his first race in the U.S. at Ferndale Fair in northern California, Kato rode primarily at

Playfair in Spokane, Washington where he was the all-time leader with 1,104 victories including two riding titles and four victories in the Playfair Mile. He is also the only active jockey to post victories at Washington's other racetracks, Longacres, Yakima Meadows and Emerald Downs in addition to Playfair. He also rode at Portland Meadows.

Although Kato grew up around Thoroughbreds, it wasn't racing that brought him to the U.S., "I just wanted to come to Disneyland," he said, thinking back to the summer of 1971. "I didn't think about riding and only knew about Hollywood Park, because it was close to the airport.

Kato has been a member of the Jock's Guild for 49 years, his career stats to date include 19,983 mounts with 2,034 wins and \$6,360,226 in purse earnings.

PEDIGREE CROSS INDEX

This Pedigree Cross Index allows a breeder to nick, inbreed or outcross his broodmares by easy reference. Indexed are the names of sires and dams included within the first three generations of all the stallions in the 2021 Stallion Directory.

Example: AFFIRMED - Charlie Barley, Mystery Storm, Peteski

In the above example, Affirmed appears in one of the first 3 generations of all the stallions listed after him.

Suppose a breeder has a mare that is a granddaughter of Mr. Prospector or has crosses of that sire in a mare's pedigree. He may want to breed her to a stallion with Northern Dancer blood to take advantage of the Northern Dancer--Mr. Prospector nick. By looking up "Northern Dancer" in this index, he can quickly see all the stallions in this register that have Northern Dancer appearing in one of the first three generations of their pedigrees.

If a breeder's mare is a granddaughter of Seattle Slew, he may wish to inbreed to that stallion and thereby get more of Seattle Slew's makeup in the foal. By checking "Seattle Slew" in the index, the breeder can readily find all the advertised stallions that have Seattle Slew in their pedigrees.

What if a breeder's mare is already inbred or linebred? She might have 2 or 3 crosses of Deputy Minister in her first four generations for example. The breeder may want to make sure the stallion he chooses for his mare has no Deputy Minister or no Deputy Minister up close in his pedigree. By looking up "Deputy Minister" in the index, he can readily see the stallions in this Stallion Register he should avoid for his mare.

- All 2020 foals of Arizona Stallions (standing the full 2018 breeding season in Arizona) will be eligible to enter the 2022 Stallion Stakes derby. This should create an exciting race as there are no early nominations, or late fees.
- Stallion owners must send a copy of the Jockey Club Report of Mares Bred to the ATBA office each breeding season. This is mandatory if your stallions offspring is to have the opportunity to participate.
- Foals need not be Arizona-bred, but must be by a stallion standing the full season in Arizona and a copy of the Report of Mares bred on file with the Arizona Thoroughbred Breeders office.
- The Arizona Stallion Stakes Derby is a restricted race for the offspring of Arizona Stallions.
