DISTRIBUTION OF THE 10% BONUS FOR CERTIFIED ARIZONA BREDS IN ALL OPEN OVERNIGHT RACES

1. If one horse wins and no others place, 100% of the 10% bonus is paid to the winner.
 2. If there are win, place and show finishers, the 10% bonus will be split 50% paid to winner, 30% to second and 20% to third.
 3. If there is a second place finisher, 30% of the 10% bonus is paid and the balance remains in the fund.
 4. If there is a third place finisher, 20% of the 10% bonus is paid and the balance remains in the fund.
- THE 10% BONUS DISTRIBUTION IS BASED ON THE TOTAL PURSE.
 - BONUS MONEY WILL BE PAID ONLY TO FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD PLACE FINISHERS.

DISTRIBUTION OF THE 20% BONUS FOR CERTIFIED ARIZONA BREDS IN ALL OVERNIGHT RESTRICTED ARIZONA BRED RACES

1. 20% bonus will be paid to the first through sixth place finishers based on the following percentages – 60% - 20% - 10% - 5% - 3% - 2%.
2. If there are less than six starters in any of the overnight restricted Arizona Bred Races, the percentages will be adjusted as to pay out the full 20% bonus on that race.

Horseracing Wins As Treasury/IRS Issue Updated Tax Rules

The U.S. Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) today announced that they will formally adopt modernized regulations regarding the withholding and reporting of pari-mutuel proceeds. The National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA) has long pressed for these updated regulations that will allow horseplayers to keep more of their winnings, thereby increasing the amount wagered on U.S. pari-mutuel racing by as much as 10 percent annually, or upwards of \$1 billion, according to independent estimates. The new rules were posted late Monday afternoon as a Public Inspection Document. They are scheduled to be officially published in Wednesday's edition of the Federal Register and will go into full effect by no later than Nov. 14, giving racing associations, totalisator companies, and advance deposit wagering (ADW) operators up to 45 days to implement these important changes; however, some may elect to start as soon as Thursday.

"These landmark U.S. Treasury regulations will have an enormously positive impact on horseplayers, the racing industry, and the federal government," said NTRA President & CEO Alex Waldrop. "I am extremely proud of the NTRA's legislative team for spearheading this effort, which will prove to be among the most meaningful regulatory advances made by our industry in decades. The results of this much-needed measure will be horseplayers keeping more of their winnings, racetracks generating more pari-mutuel handle, and government collecting additional tax revenue. This is a sure bet where everyone wins!"

Added Waldrop: "This day would never have come without the persistence of Thoroughbred racing's friends in Congress, especially Rep. John Yarmuth of Kentucky, Rep. Pat Meehan of Pennsylvania, Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell and our many bipartisan supporters on Capitol Hill. We also are indebted to the industry stakeholders and thousands of customers of Thoroughbred racing who signed our petition or submitted public comments in favor of these changes."

Under the new regulations, the IRS will consider the inclusion of a bettor's entire investment in a single pari-mutuel pool when determining the amount reported or withheld for tax purposes, as opposed to only the amount wagered on the correct result.

For example, the amount wagered by a Pick Six player who hits with one of 140 combinations on a \$1-minimum wager now will be \$140, which is the total amount bet into the Pick Six pool. This more accurate calculation will remove the significant reporting and withholding obligations on horseplayers and the unnecessary paperwork for the IRS that was a result of the prior rule that used only the \$1 bet on the single winning combination as the amount wagered.

"This is a major victory for all pari-mutuel wagering customers," said Judy Wagner, the Horseplayers' Representative on the NTRA Board of Directors and winner of the 2001 National Horseplayers Championship (NHC). "It would not have occurred without the leadership of the NTRA and the support of thousands of horseplayers who actively participated in the process to modernize these regulations."

The amended regulations, advocated by the NTRA and its legislative team, define the "amount of the wager" to include the entire amount wagered into a specific pari-mutuel pool by an individual – not just the winning base unit as is the case today – so long as all wagers made into a specific pool by an individual are made on a single totalisator ticket if the wager is placed onsite. The modernized regulations will have the same positive results for ADW customers and will not impact how those wagers are currently made.

The NTRA has pushed for the modernization of pari-mutuel withholding and reporting rules for several years. As more and more pari-mutuel wagering was directed toward exotic wagering pools it became clear that the tax rules were becoming an increasing and unfair burden on horseplayers as those outdated rules significantly increased the incidence of winning tickets subject to withholding and reporting. These new rules are the product of all the work the NTRA, and other industry stakeholders, undertook with Congressional representatives and Treasury and IRS officials.

"This represents a great triumph by the entire NTRA legislative team, including the bipartisan Horse PAC, which played an instrumental role in the passage of these regulations that will benefit all segments of the industry," said Horse PAC chairman William S. (Bill) Farish. "We thank the hundreds of individual stakeholders who contribute to Horse PAC; they played a major role in today's victory."

Waldrop noted that the NTRA has been working behind the scenes since January with industry groups – including totalisator companies, ADWs, and racing organizations – to ensure a smooth implementation for customers.

"For the industry to fully realize the benefits of modernized regulations for pari-mutuel withholding and reporting it is essential that we deliver a seamless transition to our customers," he said. "We are optimistic that the industry will be fully prepared to institute these landmark changes by no later than November 14."

Selecting the Right Stallion

Breeding a thoroughbred can be both exciting and daunting experience. There are numerous considerations when selecting the right stallion for your mare, for example, are you breeding to race or to sell, and what is your budget and expectations?

What Attributes to look for in a stallion?



When choosing a stallion for your broodmare there are many questions you need to ask. You need to consider not just the genetic lines and physical type of both mare and stallion but also the financial considerations as well.

Some of the more important questions to ask, when selecting the right stallion are:

- ☞ **Conformation** – Is the stallion a good impressive physical type or does he have any conformation faults that maybe passed onto the foal?
- ☞ **Pedigree** – This is where it's important to do your research. Is the stallion a suitable match for your mare and has it been a successful cross in the past?
- ☞ **Temperament** – does he display good behavior and are his foals of a nice nature?
- ☞ **Compliment your mare** – if your mare has any conformation faults will the stallion help correct these faults. If your mare is bred to be a sprinter or race over more ground will the stallion's pedigree suit her and enhance that or have a negative impact?
- ☞ **Service Fee** – Is it within your budget and set to market value?
- ☞ **Terms of cover** – do they provide a live foal guarantee, when will the service fee be payable?
- ☞ **Travel Costs, fees and agistment** – Where is the stallion located, what costs are involved in getting your mare there?
- ☞ **Fertility** – Does he have a good fertility rate and regularly return a good percentage of positive pregnancies tests in comparison to mares he covers?
- ☞ **Previous breeding record** – How many mares has he served and over how many years? Of his foals already racing, what success have they had on the racetrack; provided they are old enough to be racing.
- ☞ **Sale ability** – If you are breeding to sell what prices have the yearlings been making at the sales and are they getting a good return compared to the stallion's service fee?
- ☞ **Previous progeny** – Try and inspect foals from previous years and see if the stallion produces a nice,

correct well developed type. ing the stallion's statistics and pedigree but his physical type as well all are so very important. There a plenty of professionals out there that can help you with any if not all these things.

What you should Avoid in a stallion

Bad behavior

☞ Poor conformation – check for any conformation faults, some may not be of a concern, but it's believed some things can be passed onto the foal such as parrot mouth and leg deformities.

☞ Low fertility – you don't want to send your mare to a sub fertile stallion only to find out towards the end of the season he has a low percentage of pregnancies.

☞ Poor results – If the stallion has been at stud for numerous years and is not producing the winners on the racetrack it's probably best to avoid. If he isn't getting winners, he won't be making good results in the sales ring either.


☞ Not supported – If he hasn't been supported with good quality mares in previous seasons or serving a decent book every year it probably suggests he isn't the best producer.

☞ Pedigree – As mentioned previously it's important to make sure the stallion you select has a pedigree that is a good match for your mare. If he has a weak family line, he is probably not going to give you the quality foal you are looking for.

Selecting the right stallion is not an easy task, but can be very rewarding especially when you watch your horse win its first race or the hammer fall in the sale ring for that price you where hoping for. Remember research is key, not just assessing the stallion's statistics and pedigree but his physical type as well all are so very important. There a plenty of professionals out there that can help you with any if not all these things.



UNDERSTANDING THE MARE'S BREEDING CYCLE CHART

On horse farms, the breeding shed is perhaps the most important place for accurate record keeping.¹ Understanding as much as possible regarding the mare's breeding cycle can give horse owners and breeders an edge with regard to achieving their breeding objectives. Records for breeding management, estimating foaling dates and evaluating breeding performance go a long way toward cultivating such an understanding and for maintaining sound breeding practices.

Record evaluation is essential in the horse breeders decision making. The type and detail of records will depend upon the management of breeding practices on each facility, but the overall requirements are generally the same.

Mares begin to come into estrus early in the Spring, with their estrous cycle being approximately 21 days. Usually, the mare will be receptive to breeding for about five days toward the end of her cycle. Most of the available literature maintains that the mare should be bred within the 12 hour period prior ovulation in order to have the best chance of getting her in foal.

The Breeding Life Cycle of the Mare

Fillies reach sexual maturity at approximately 18 months of age. At this point, she will begin to cycle regularly during Spring, Summer and early Fall, however most breeders maintain that the optimal age group for easy breeding will be found with mares between the ages of about 4 and 12.²

"The primary environmental factor causing mares to cycle normally is increased hours of light (photoperiod). Artificial lighting can be used to induce mares to cycle earlier in the year."³ The estrous cycle, which is to be distinguished from estrus itself (the "heat" portion of the estrous cycle), begins to normalize in late April or early May through August, which is the normal breeding season for horses. During this period, mares will have an estrous cycle of approximately 21 days.

The estrous cycle consists of two phases:

The estrus phase (in heat), and
The diestrus phase (out of heat).

Estrus typically lasts for approximately six days, but can be as short as four or as long as ten days. This is usually individually dependent on the mare. The diestrus portion of the cycle lasts approximately 15 days, but can vary from 12 to 18 days. From September through March, mares stop cycling normally. This is called anestrus.

As increasing daylight stimulates the receptor centers in the brain to trigger reproductive hormones, these hormones begin the pattern of regular periods of estrus, also known as heat. The estrous cycle is the time period from one ovulation to the next. The average cycle is 22 days and this can vary by a few days especially at the beginning or ending of breeding season. "Generally in March, many mares

begin to develop ovarian activity. This early activity may not be accompanied by ovulation, but beginning in May, with longer daylight hours, warmer temperatures, and the arrival of green grass, nearly all mares are cycling consistently, with conception rates peaking in June.”

While private horse owners breeding their mare for the first time may need to rely on research, fellow equestrians and their veterinarian for input, breeding operations (horse farms) have developed comprehensive systems for ensuring that they meet their quotas and continue to keep their operations financially viable.


The goal of a breeding farm is to produce live foals. To determine whether the goal was reached several ratios are calculated from breeding records. The most routine evaluation is pregnancy rate. This is the number of mares pregnant on a specific day, divided by the number bred. Pregnancy rate can be determined from one ovulatory period or on the total breeding season. For example, early pregnancy checks of 20 mares revealed that 17 had embryos and three were open. The pregnancy rate would be 17, divided by 20, multiplied by 100.

$$\text{Pregnancy rate} = (17/20) \times 100 = 85\% \text{ pregnant}$$

Foaling rates are the percent of matings that produce a live foal. It is determined by dividing the number of live foals by the number of mares bred. For example, foaling rate would be 75 percent if 15 of 20 mares bred produced foals.

$$\text{Foaling rate} = (15/20 \times 100) = 75\%$$

In most cases (outside of a horse farm), once a mare is in estrus, it is recommended that the breeder solicit a veterinarian to monitor the mare closely for ovulation. The foundation of a good reproductive program starts with a veterinarian that has good knowledge of equine reproductive physiology and is experienced in managing mares during estrus and early pregnancy to achieve optimal results.



Planning For the Long Term

Many large and small horse breeding operations have crafted breeding cycle charts for monitoring their mares and for planning their seasonal breeding. While these can be helpful to the horse owner who is planning to breed their mare, seasoned breeders typically advise that owners draw up their own based upon the particulars of their mare(s) since all animals vary.

While fillies do become sexually mature at approximately 18 months, the literature maintains that they are still experiencing growth during this time that may be hindered by pregnancy. Thus, it is recommended that the ideal age to begin foaling is approximately four years of age. Mares are capable of continuing to breed until late in life and do not usually suffer ill effects if nutrition and condition are maintained.

The training can be rigorous, but great effort is taken to ensure the mental and physical soundness of each animal. Races are monitored, injuries are documented, and protective practices are developed to mitigate the potential risks. The health and safety of the horse is foremost.

New technologies such as positron emission topography and magnetic resonance imaging, in addition to other cutting-edge imaging modalities, are frequently employed to assist veterinary professionals to better understand and get to the root of any medical issues that arise.

Since T.I.P.'s inception in 2012, more than 45,000 Thoroughbreds have competed in thousands of shows in almost every state and Canadian province as part of this exciting program.



The Maker's Mark Secretariat Center (MMSC) is located at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, Kentucky, the "Horse Capital of the World." One of the most recognizable re-schooling and adoption facilities for retired racehorses in the country, MMSC works tirelessly to "prepare off-track Thoroughbreds for happy, healthy, and successful post-track careers by giving them a broad-based foundation of skills to ensure a harmonious match with their adopters."



Likewise, New Vocations, the largest racehorse adoption program in the country, works to provide "a safety net for [retired] horses by matching them with qualified individuals and following up on their rehabilitation and vocational training to ensure a successful transition." The organization retrains and rehomes hundreds of Thoroughbred racehorses each year, placing more than 7,000 in qualified homes to date.





Stallion owners must send a copy of the Jockey Club Report of Mares Bred to the ATBA office each breeding season. This is mandatory if your stallions offspring is to have the opportunity to participate.


